Retro Gadgets 1

Retro Gadgets 1 as an in depth sampled collection of toy keyboards.

We have put the deep care into capture the nuances of these “toys”. Every half note of the instruments natural range and articulation possibilities has been captured. To prepare these old gadgets for modern use in a DAW based studio we also fine tuned each note exactly so you can add true retro flavor instantly in your production without any hassle and compromises.

Waddington Compute-A-Tune

A more advanced and very good sounding 70-ties keyboard, rare to find and with a bleep sound that suits “electronica” and retro pop well.

Dubrek Stylophone (Black)

The most common of the Stylophone models with a middle range. Every half note with and without vibrato has been sampled.

Dubrek Stylophone (White)

This is the high pitched Stylophone model. Every half note with and without vibrato has been sampled.

To prepare these old gadgets for modern use in a DAW based studio we also fine tuned each note exactly so you can add true retro flavor instantly in your production without any hassle and compromises.

V-Tech Music Major

A small toy keyboard released before the sample area. This little monster used by “Beck” and other contemporary musicians has real speech synthesis and a sound you can’t get anywhere else. The lo-fi sound this piece of circuit produces is a must have in your arsenal of sound.

148 WAV samples covering all the presets and speech sounds chromatically. You also get the 12 preset drumloops in Rx2 format.

WOC 100

If the Stylophone is a Wasp the WOC 100 is a Bumblebee, a Hong Kong clone of the famous Stylophone twice as big and with a lot more fatness in the sound. The vibrato is to die for...

62 WAV samples covering the complete range of the WOC 100 in both strait and vibrato mode. We also made a very special “shut down” program that gets the WOC 100 to sound like a rubber band being plucked. We pressed a tone and shut the machine down... for all notes of course.

Texas Instruments Speak & Music

Texas Instruments made a keyboard, probably based on the same sound chip as their talking educational machines. The presets oozing of overtones and character. Everything that sounds has been sampled from this machine, chromatically.

111 WAV samples covering all presets, FX and speech sequences.

We have put the deep care into capture the nuances of these “toys”. Every half note of the instruments natural range and articulation possibilities has been captured. To prepare these old gadgets for modern use in a DAW based studio we also fine tuned each note exactly so you can add true retro flavor instantly in your production without any hassle and compromises.

Casio VL-1 (VL-Tone)

The Lo-Fi legendary synthesizer and calculator, used in songs by “The Human League”, “Trio” and many more in the 80-ties. We have sampled the 5 presets, every note in the whole key range that is G1-B5. All samples are generously looped so you get all the real fluctuations of the sound. You also get all the preset rhythms in Rx2 format.

ASAHI

This obscure Japanese organ delivers a roaming saturated sound, very handy for leads. All notes has been sampled and carefully looped.

Harward H359

Probably from the Stylophone days, made in UK and looks like a pocket calculator. Very portable and screams like a pig

Retro Gadgets 3 contains:

- 10 loops in Rx2 (Re-cycle) format

Retro Gadgets 4

Retro Gadgets vol. 4 continuing the popular series with yet another bunch of rare and unique sounding instruments.

We recreated the sounds of these keyboards and also used the potential of the sampler engines to create polyphonic pads, leads etc. based on the core sounds. This technique to use the multisampled keyboard sounds as oscillators gives a more analogue and organic result than using VA oscillators, in our opinion.

Polivox Faemi mini

A very rare organ/synth produced in USSR.

Concept 2000

Some sort of educational keyboard with a plastic edge to the sound.

Mix Me DJ

The complete DJ/Scratch/synth production studio for children containing a lot of lo-fi 8 bit noises.

Yamaha PS1

A great sounding analogue home keyboard from the early 80-ties.

Stylophone Woodstyle

The square version of the cult keyboard from UK with a more snappy sound than the black and white versions.

- 42 programs for Kontakt 1+
- 38 programs for HALion
- 14 programs in SoundFont format
- 4 loops in Rx2 (Re-cycle) format
